

# BREAKING (PARKING) NEWS!!

Count on the Parking Services Division at Florida Gulf Coast University for your parking needs and information:

Important things you need to know for the '08-'09 year:

- With the addition of Garage #2 and the reopening of Lot #2, there is more than sufficient parking for this school year. For this year, Lot#2: north side is student parking; south side is faculty/staff.
- Park in marked spaces only. Do not park in the grass or along curbs.
- Student vehicles are prohibited from the rear of Howard Hall and the rear of the library. Those are restricted access roads. Dropping off of students is prohibited.
- DO NOT block, park or obstruct any Handicapped parking space.
- DO NOT block or park within 15 feet of any FIRE HYDRANT, or 30 feet of any stop sign.
- Visitor Parking Locations: Parking Lot #5, Parking Garages and Parking Garage Auxiliary parking.

- Commuter Student Parking Locations: Parking Lots# 2-north, 4, 6, 7, Parking Garage #1 & #2 and Parking Garage Auxiliary parking.



- Housing Students: Please use your shuttle service, “DO NOT DRIVE to main campus until after 5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. After 5:00 p.m. and weekends all lots are general parking, EXCLUDING RESERVED/RESTRICTED SPACES.”

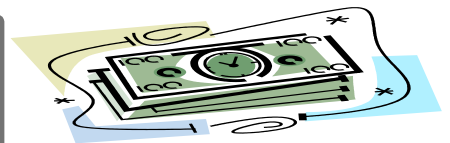


- All Vehicles must be registered with a valid permit to park on campus.

- Parking Citations: can be paid by credit card, check, or cash at the cashier’s office and by check or cash at Parking Service office.

## Florida Gulf Coast University Parking Services Rules & Regulations (Summary)

### RULE

University parking and traffic regulations are enforced twenty-four (24) hours a day, each day of the calendar year.

No motor vehicles, other than police, emergency or service vehicles, shall be operated or parked on grass, walkways, sidewalks, fire hydrant areas, service areas, or other prohibited zones, except where specifically permitted by signage.

Parking areas restricted by classification, time or purpose shall be considered "no parking" zones to those individuals who do not fall within the restriction of the classification.

Motorcycles, motor scooters, mopeds, and bicycles shall be parked only in special racks or designated areas and shall not occupy spaces designated for automobiles. Motorcycle parking is only allowed in designated areas of lots 2, 3, 5 and garage.

Parking garage will be closed to all vehicles and persons from midnight to 5:00 a.m. daily. After a garage is officially closed, all remaining vehicles will be cited and may be towed and impounded. The use of skateboards, roller-skates, in line skates, or similar devices, are prohibited in parking garages.

Parking Violations Fines: General Violations - \$20.00, Disabled Accessible Space Violations - \$200.00, Reserved Space Violations - \$100.00. If payment is received after Ten (10) Days a \$10.00 late fee will be assessed in addition to the above charge. Fines may be paid on Gulfline with a credit card, or at the Cashier's Office with cash, check or credit card. Payments may also be made at the Parking Services Office with cash or check.

Faculty/staff and students shall file appeals electronically through Gulfline within (10) days. After ten days, your right to appeal the citation is forfeited. For instructions on how to appeal, you may review the Division of Parking Services website at <http://admin.fgcu.edu/police/appeals.html>.

Lack of parking spaces, or the failure of others to observe these regulations shall not be valid defenses to violation of the University's parking and traffic regulations.

The Eagle Express Campus Shuttle operates from 7:30AM to 9:30PM Monday through Friday during the fall and spring terms (excluding holidays). See Parking Services web site for shuttle routes – <http://admin.fgcu.edu/police/parking.html>.

### REGULATIONS

The owner or driver receiving a permit may register a maximum of two (2) vehicles under the same permit, except that students residing on campus (Housing Students), may register only one vehicle.

Student parking fees for initial parking permit/decal are included in the per-credit hour fees of their tuition charges. Permits/decals must be picked up from Parking Services.

Faculty/Staff may obtain term permits at \$43 per term, annual permits for \$107, or reserved space permits for \$482 (subject to availability). Payroll reduction option is only available during the Fall Term.

Lost or stolen decals or permits will not be replaced and the registrant will be required to purchase a new decal or permit at a fee of \$105.00 for faculty/staff reserved space parking or a fee of \$30.00 for all other parking permits.

A hanging style permit shall be displayed at all times while on campus on the rear view mirror, or otherwise displayed in the windshield, with the permit number facing outward.
